 - April 2010, Bylaws Chapter U:
 - ... Protection of the Town of Acton's water bodies and groundwater
 - ... Authority for permitting, inspection, and monitoring of discharges to the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4)



FY17 Short-Term Goals

- #4: Develop Implementation Plan for New Storm Water Permits – Selectman Adachi
 - November 2015, Bylaws Chapter X Stormwater
 Management and Erosion & Sediment Control
 - ... Compliance with the "construction" and "postconstruction" minimum control measures in the EPA/MassDEP permit for discharges from Acton's municipal stormwater system.
 - ... Complements Chapter U

FY17 Long-Term Goals

- #1: Develop Comprehensive Capital Plan –

 - The Capital Improvement Planning Committee studies proposals from the Acton Town Manager and the Acton-Boxborough Regional School District which involve major tangible items with a total project cost of more than \$100,000 in a single year or over \$100,000 in multiple years and which would likely require an article at Town Meeting for the project's authorization.

 - The CIPC shall make a report with recommendations to the Finance Committee and the Board of Selectmen on these proposals.

- 1) Increase reserve use from \$1.6m
- 2) Lower untaxed levy capacity from \$985k
- 3) Cut entity spending below 3.3%
- 4) Combination of any of the above
